Hindi Divas was celebrated at High Commission of India at Canberra, in association with the Canberra Hindi School run by Mr. Santosh Gupta, on 29th September-2017 from 4pm to 6pm.

High Commissioner of India Shri Gondane addressed the gathering, directing that a committee be set up for encouraging Hindi learning in Australia, amongst the children of diaspora and wider Australian community. He also sought volunteers for teaching of Hindi from amongst the Indian diaspora and have a working knowledge of Hindi.

A Hindi essay writing and Competition in the age groups of 0-5 years, 6-13 years, and 14-18 years was part of the series of events. Poems recital by some members of Indian diaspora in Canberra, and an address by Mrs Rina Singh, a Hindi teacher with the Australian National University was also organized.
